DANCE

Preschool Dance

Mondays, 10:00-10:30 am - Jessie Fincher
18 months - 5 years

This class will focus on basic ballet technique delivered in a way that will hold the attention of young students. Children will develop an awareness of music and rhythms and will learn to use their bodies and imaginations along with their ballet movements. 18 months – 2 years will take this class with a parent or caregiver.

Capoeira

6 years - 106 years (yes, you read that right!)

Capoeira is a physical discipline with movement originating among Brazilian slaves. It is treated as both a martial-arts and a dance form. Athletic-wear should be worn with bare feet.

GYMNASTICS

Preschool Play Gymnastics

Boys and girls 2 to 5 years of age will explore basic gymnastic fundamentals in a themed environment and fun atmosphere. Students will begin to develop strength, flexibility, coordination, and confidence, through basic gymnastics skills and stretching, while improving coordination and dominant movement patterns.

Rec 1 Gymnastics

This recreational program for girls includes vault, bars, beam and floor instruction for beginners. Emphasis is placed on conditioning, body and spatial awareness for skill accomplishments. Safety is our number one priority. Students are required to master the fundamentals of the current level before progressing to the next level.
