Applications must first be looked over by the Department Director and will then be submitted to the Executive Director and the Board of Directors for approval with the Director's recommendation. The Board meets one time monthly and will review the application at that time and will let the Department Director know of their final decision. You will then receive a phone call from the Department Director letting you know if and how much of a scholarship you will receive. Scholarships are not retroactive, so they will go into effect once they are approved by the board. You will be responsible for full tuition up to that point. In order to be considered for a scholarship, the following provisions must be met:

- Applicant must attach 3 letters of recommendation.
 (Letters of recommendation can come from school teachers, coaches, group leaders, etc.)
- Applicant must attach family's/guardians' previous year's tax return to this packet. If parents/guardians file separately, both returns must be included.
- Applicant must perform at least 5 hours of Creative Arts Guild community volunteer hours in exchange for receiving a scholarship.
- Scholarship student must attend regularly scheduled classes. Repeated unexcused absences could result in revocation of scholarship.

It is the Creative Arts Guild's hope to be able to offer scholarships to deserving families that will hold the Guild in highest regard and promote the Guild's programs in both word and action.
